Tsavo East National Park

One of Kenya's largest and oldest parks, Tsavo East is famed for its red-dusted elephants, dramatic Yatta Plateau, and the Galana River snaking through vast open savannahs. Wildlife sightings range from lions and cheetahs to giraffes, zebras, and hundreds of bird species.

Amboseli National Park

A photographer's paradise, Amboseli offers unparalleled views of snowcapped Mount Kilimanjaro towering over open plains. Known for its large elephant herds, the park also shelters lions, cheetahs, giraffes, and rich birdlife across its swamps and grasslands.

Nairobi

Kenya's vibrant capital blends modern city life with wild beauty. From bustling markets and cultural centers to Nairobi National Park — where lions roam against a backdrop of skyscrapers — the city offers a unique mix of urban energy and natural wonders.

Lake Naivasha

A tranquil freshwater lake in the Great Rift Valley, Lake Naivasha is a haven for birdwatchers and nature lovers. Visitors can enjoy boat rides among hippos, fish eagles, and pelicans, or walk among freely roaming giraffes, zebras, and antelopes on Crescent Island.

Lake Nakuru National Park

This scenic park is renowned for its rhino sanctuary, large populations of lions and leopards, and — in season — vibrant pink flocks of flamingoes. Acacia woodlands and the shimmering lake provide a stunning backdrop for game drives.

Maasai Mara National Reserve

Kenya's premier safari destination, the Maasai Mara is home to the Big Five and the spectacular Great Migration of wildebeest and zebras (July–October). Its endless golden plains, dramatic predator action, and rich Maasai culture make it a world-class wildlife experience.



SEVEN-DAY KENYA CIRCUIT – MOMBASA TO MAASAI MARA TO NAIROBI

Day 1: Mombasa to Tsavo East - Into the Wild

Depart Mombasa at dawn for Tsavo East National Park. Enter via Bachuma Gate and begin your first wildlife drive through rugged terrain known for the famous red elephants. After a safaristyle lunch at Voi Safari Lodge, continue the adventure with an afternoon game drive. Settle in for the night at a comfortable lodge, surrounded by nature.

Day 2: Tsavo to Amboseli – Kilimanjaro Views & Elephants

Travel west toward Amboseli National Park, famed for its elephant herds and views of snowcapped Mt. Kilimanjaro. After check-in and lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive and team photography opportunities against the mountain backdrop. Evening networking over a bonfire is optional.

Day 3: Amboseli to Nairobi – Urban Comforts

After a relaxed morning breakfast and an optional game drive, head to Nairobi. Arrive in time for a late lunch and check in at a city hotel. The rest of the evening is at leisure, perfect for catching up on emails or informal group discussions.

Day 4: Nairobi to Naivasha – Lakeside Escape

Depart for Lake Naivasha, with a stop at View Point Escarpment for breathtaking Rift Valley scenery. Upon arrival, enjoy a boat ride among hippos and birds. Later, walk with animals at Crescent Island, a unique safari experience. Overnight at a scenic lakeside lodge.

Day 5: Naivasha to Nakuru – Flamingoes & Rhinos

A short drive takes you to Lake Nakuru National Park, where AFRACA delegates will enjoy game drives with opportunities to spot black and white rhinos, lions, and flocks of flamingoes. A productive afternoon in nature leads to dinner and rest in a nearby lodge.

Day 6: Nakuru to Maasai Mara – Enter the Icon

Depart for Maasai Mara, Kenya's premier game reserve. Arrive in time for a late lunch and embark on an evening game drive through the savannahs teeming with wildlife. Stay at a luxury tented camp and gather by the fire to debrief and bond as a group.

Day 7: Full Day in the Maasai Mara – The Safari Finale

Enjoy a full-day game drive in the Mara. Expect lion prides, cheetahs, elephants, and—if in season—the Great Migration. Visit a Maasai village for a cultural exchange. After lunch in the bush, continue the drive or opt for a hot air balloon ride (optional at an extra cost). Later, drive back to Nairobi or overnight in the Mara, depending on preferences.
