Kisite Mpunguti Marine Park

Located off the coast of Shimoni near the Tanzanian border, Kisite Mpunguti is one of Kenya's most stunning marine parks. It's known for its crystal-clear waters, vibrant coral reefs, and rich marine life, including dolphins, sea turtles, and tropical fish. Ideal for snorkeling, diving, and dhow sailing, it offers a serene, untouched ocean experience.

Fort Jesus & Old Town, Mombasa

Built by the Portuguese in 1593, Fort Jesus is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a symbol of Mombasa's strategic importance in trade and colonization. The adjacent Old Town boasts narrow, winding streets lined with Swahili, Arab, and Portuguese architecture, showcasing centuries of coastal culture, spice trade history, and vibrant local life.

Wasini Island

Located south of Diani, Wasini Island is a tranquil destination best explored by dhow. The island is known for its coral gardens, ancient Swahili village, and welcoming local communities. Visitors can enjoy fresh seafood lunches, walk along coral paths, explore the Shimoni caves, and immerse themselves in the slower pace of coastal island life.
