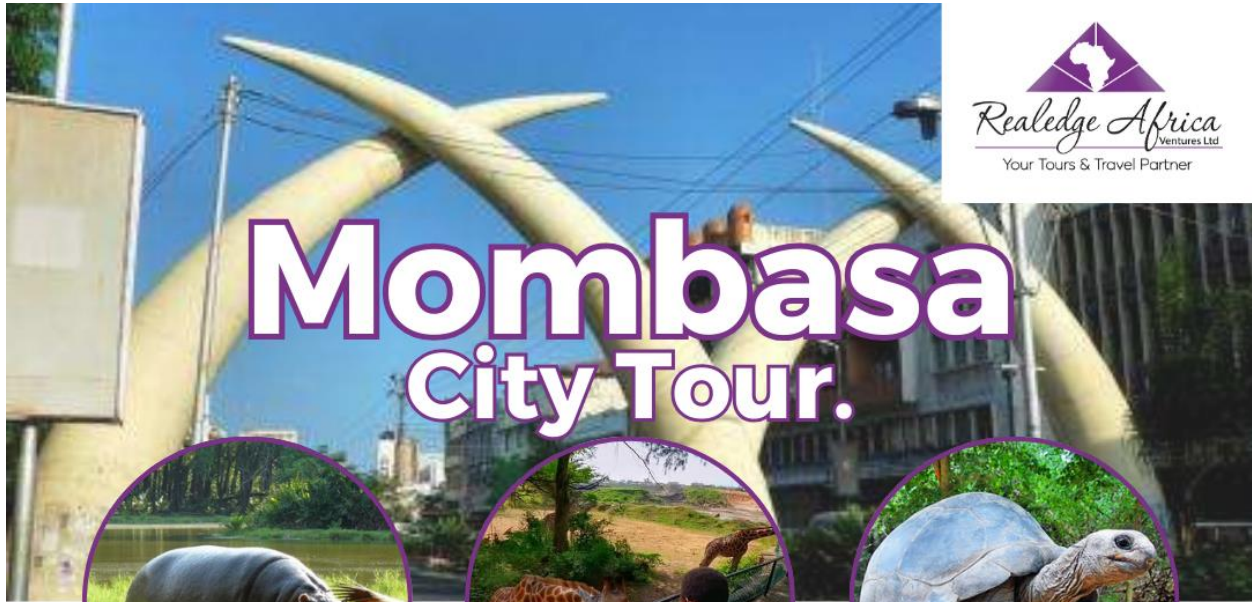

About the destinations.

Mombasa Tusks – Iconic aluminum tusks arching over Moi Avenue, built to commemorate Queen Elizabeth II's visit in 1952. A perfect photo spot symbolizing Mombasa's heritage.

Old Town – A charming maze of narrow streets, Swahili houses, carved wooden doors, and spice-scented markets—a living blend of Arab, Portuguese, and British influence.

Fort Jesus – A 16th-century Portuguese fortress and UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its walls hold centuries of maritime history, battles, and trade secrets.

Haller Park – A lush sanctuary transformed from a cement quarry into a thriving wildlife park. Home to giraffes, hippos, giant tortoises, and a variety of birdlife.

Kick off the day with a private vehicle pick-up from your hotel, accompanied by an experienced local guide who will enrich your journey with stories of Mombasa's rich past and vibrant present.

Your first stop is the iconic Mombasa Tusks, symbolic of the city's historical ties to trade and royalty. From here, immerse yourself in the centuries-old charm of Old Town, wandering through narrow alleys lined with Swahili, Arab, and Portuguese architecture. Enjoy a guided tour of Fort Jesus, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that offers insight into Mombasa's strategic role in the Indian Ocean trade.

After a refreshing coastal lunch (not included), visit Haller Park, an ecological sanctuary where giraffes, hippos, and giant tortoises roam freely. The serene park offers the perfect setting for relaxed networking and reflection.
