Fort Jesus & Old Town

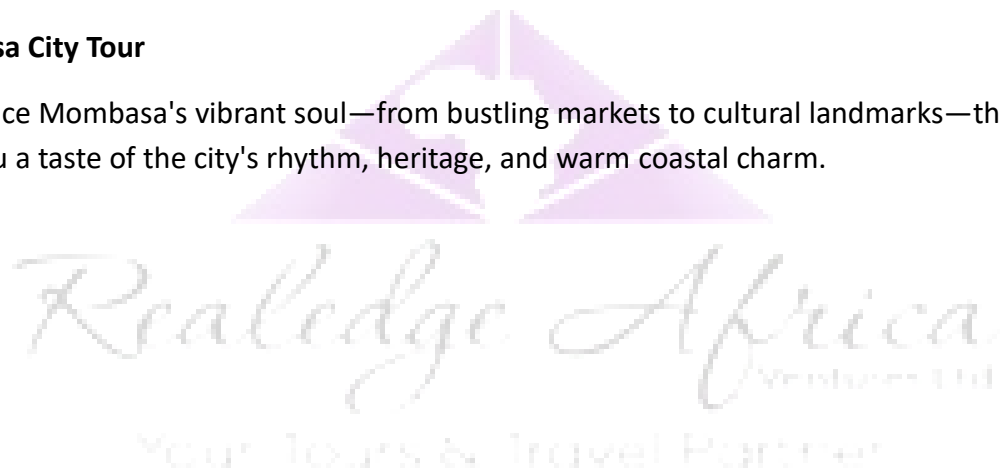

THREE-DAY NORTH & SOUTH COAST TOUR – OCEAN, RUINS & THE OLD PORT

Day 1: Wasini Island – Marine Safari & Local Culture

Your coastal escape begins early with a scenic drive south to Shimoni, where a dhow cruise sets sail into the protected waters of Kisite Mpunguti Marine Park. You will enjoy crystal-clear snorkeling, dolphin sightings, and gentle sea breezes. Disembark at Wasini Island for a walk through the coral village and mangroves, guided by local hosts sharing Swahili heritage.

Feast on a freshly prepared seafood lunch before returning to the mainland. Head back to Mombasa and check into a serene beach resort on the North Coast. Dinner is an open-air affair—perfect for informal team bonding under the stars.

Day 2: Gede Ruins & Mambrui Sand Dunes – Mystery & Majesty

After breakfast, depart for the Gede Ruins, a hidden gem near Watamu. This ancient Swahili town, over 600 years old, offers AFRACA guests a fascinating journey into archaeology, mystery, and Islamic-African coastal heritage. The surrounding forest and birdlife create a uniquely atmospheric site.

After lunch, continue north to Mambrui, where the golden sand dunes rise majestically by the sea. This lesser-known location is ideal for light hikes, reflection, and photography. Return to Mombasa by evening, where your resort offers a calm evening by the ocean.

Day 3: Mombasa City Experience – From History to Harmony

Begin your final day with a cultural dive into Old Town Mombasa—exploring historic alleys, spice markets, and the iconic Fort Jesus. Learn about the city's centuries-old maritime significance. Then, switch gears and connect with nature at Haller Park, where AFRACA guests can feed giraffes and enjoy lush forest trails.

After a relaxed lunch at a coastal restaurant, stroll through the newly revamped Mama Ngina Waterfront, soaking in panoramic harbor views and cooling breezes. End the tour with souvenir shopping or a short visit to Bombolulu Workshop, before returning to your hotel or airport in the late afternoon.
